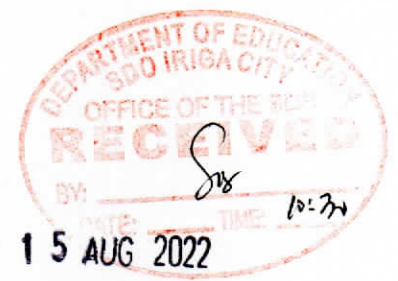

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## How to Enroll in the Course

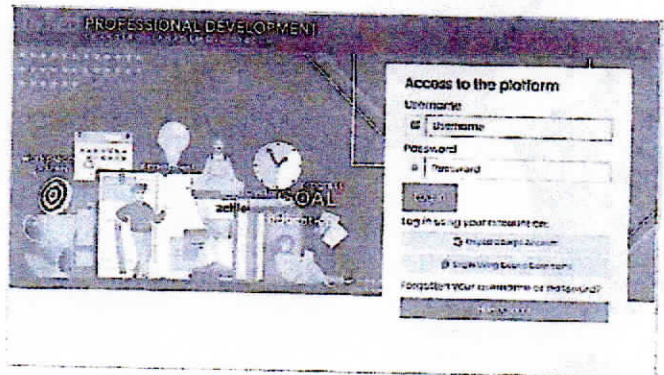
Welcome to the Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on **INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC) in SCHOOLS**. This course aims to help school heads, teachers, and school personnel to better understand the topic of Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) in schools, its relevance to school operations, and the implementation of IPC measures. The course will also explore the connection between Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in Schools (WinS) and IPC, as part of the Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OK sa DepEd) program. To enroll in the course, you need to have an account in the DepEd's Professional Development LMS, a Training System for Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel.

### Step 1:
