1. Attached is a Memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, DM-OULS-2026-115 titled **“Call for Nominations to the Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) Training Programme on Leadership in Schools”** dated **March 12, 2026**, for information and guidance.

2. The program offers the following courses:
The Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP), in collaboration with the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), announces a training programme on **Leadership in Schools** to be conducted **on July 13–17, 2026 in Singapore (onsite)**. The program aims to enhance the competencies of school leaders in key areas such as:

- Curriculum and instructional leadership
- Strategic management
- Coaching and change management

3. **Eligibility Requirements:**

Nominees must:

- Be mid- to senior-level officials involved in leadership and strategic planning
- Be proficient in written and spoken English
- Be in good health
- Have at least two (2) years of government service
- Hold a permanent position with very satisfactory performance ratings
- Have no pending administrative or criminal case
- Be physically fit to travel and possess a valid passport

4. **Program Provisions:**

The Government of Singapore will cover course fees, accommodation, meals,

transportation during training, and provide a daily allowance. However, **round trip airfare shall be charged to the sending office subject to availability of funds.**

5. Each Schools Division Office is encouraged to nominate **one (1) qualified applicant.** Selection shall be based on merit, and nominees must submit complete documentary requirements including Personal Data Sheet (PDS), IPCR ratings, service record, and other supporting documents.

6. Interested applicants are advised to submit their complete documents to this Office **on or before April 1, 2026** through Ms. Sharon C. Saldo, to allow screening and endorsement prior to the national deadline.

7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
