1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 572, s. 2026 regarding the conduct of the Learning Systems Reform Policies Orientation for School Heads and Teachers, this Addendum is hereby issued to provide clarifications on the schedule, expected number of participants, attendance arrangements, and attendance requirements.

2. The orientation for teachers and supervisors (EPS and PSDS), both onsite and cluster viewing participants, is scheduled on May 15, 2026.

3. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are enjoined to strictly observe the Expected Number of Onsite Participants at the Ibalong Center for Recreation, Legazpi City, as follows:

- Albay - 375 participants only
- Legazpi City - 100 participants only
- Ligao City - 100 participants only
- Iriga City - 100 participants only
- Naga City - 100 participants only
- Tabaco City - 100 participants only
- Sorsogon City - 100 participants only

All EPSs, PSDSs, School Heads, and Teachers **who are not included in the onsite allocation shall attend the orientation through the designated cluster viewing locations** assigned by their respective SDOs.

4. To ensure the orderly conduct of the orientation and proper documentation of participation, all attendees are required to observe the following attendance and participation requirements:

Orientation Proper (May 15, 2026 at 8:00 am to 5:00pm)

- a. Onsite Participants
 - Sign the attendance sheet upon arrival at the venue
 - Participate in all scheduled activities
 - Remain at the venue and stay focused on the sessions
 - Aim to learn from all discussions and presentations
- b. Cluster Viewing Participants
 - Record attendance through the online attendance mechanism
 - Participate in all scheduled activities
 - Remain in the assigned cluster viewing venue
 - No individual participation via MS Teams; participants must join their assigned cluster
 - Be ready for group activities
 - Keep camera turned on showing all cluster participants

Post-Orientation Requirements

All participants shall accomplish the Post-Orientation Evaluation, accessible from May 15, 2026 (4:00 PM) to May 16, 2026 (11:45 PM).

The evaluation link will be posted during the activity.

5. The Cluster Focal Points are advised to ensure compliance with the following:

 - b. Create one (1) dedicated cluster for all Division EPSs, PSDSs and other SDO Officials to ensure coordinated participation and effective facilitation during the orientation sessions.

LEARNING SYSTEMS REFORM POLICIES ORIENTATION FOR SCHOOL HEADS AND TEACHERS

1. Pursuant to DM-LS-2026-131, an orientation on the Learning Systems Reform Policies will be conducted for elementary and secondary school heads and Regional and Division officials on May 6, 2026, and May 15, 2026 for supervisors and teachers. This activity will utilize a hybrid modality to ensure comprehensive coverage across the region. Participants are categorized into two groups based on their location and proximity to the primary venue:

2. Participants in Group A (Onsite Group) are requested to pre-register using the link which will be sent through their respective CID chiefs.

3. To ensure an interactive and seamless experience for Group B, Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are directed to:

- Organize viewing clusters for their respective school heads and teachers. Viewing parties must be arranged based on local feasibility. Options may include:
 - ✓ By division for orientation of school heads
 - ✓ By school with 50 or more teachers for the orientation of teachers
 - ✓ By district or school cluster for smaller groups or shared geographical areas.

School heads of private schools may be invited and allowed to participate. To maintain the collaborative nature of the sessions, individual viewing will not be allowed. All participants must join an established cluster.

- Choose a venue with strong and reliable internet connectivity.
- Direct ICT Units to provide technical support at each site to facilitate real-time interaction with the central panel, led by Asec. Jerome Buenviaje.
- Submit a formal list of clustered viewing sites through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) for monitoring purposes. A link for this report shall be provided through the CID Chiefs.

4. Expenses for the onsite orientation shall be charged to funds lodged at the CLMD while expenses for the clustered viewing shall be charged to local funds all subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
