CONDUCT OF LITERACY MAPPING ACTIVITIES FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chiefs, CID and SGOD

ALS Teachers, BLWs, and All Others Concerned

1. In line with the implementation and strengthening of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) program and pursuant to the goals of expanding access to basic education for out-of-school children, youth, and adults, all ALS teachers are hereby directed to conduct **Literacy Mapping Activities** in their respective areas of assignment from **May 06 to 29, 2026**.
2. The Literacy Mapping aims to identify, locate, and profile potential ALS learners, including Out-of-School Youth (OSY), adults, and other individuals who have not completed basic education, to ensure their inclusion in appropriate ALS programs such as Basic Literacy Program (BLP), Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Elementary, Junior High School, and ALS Senior High School.
3. All concerned ALS teachers and BLWs are instructed to:
 - a. Conduct house-to-house visits and community surveys within their assigned barangays;
 - b. Coordinate with barangay officials, community leaders, and other stakeholders to facilitate efficient data gathering;
 - c. Ensure accuracy and completeness of collected data using the prescribed literacy mapping form (AF1); and
 - d. Encode and update the collected literacy mapping data on a daily basis in the official Google Sheet through the following link: <https://bit.ly/MAPPINGSY26-27>, ensuring timely, complete, and accurate entries.
4. Consistent with Civil Service Commission (CSC) rules and DepEd guidelines, ALS teachers shall be entitled to vacation service credits for services rendered, considering that this activity is conducted during summer break. Non-teaching personnel who will render services on weekends shall be entitled to Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC), which may be availed of as compensatory time off.
5. School Heads (SASHS, SNHS, RNTVS) are hereby requested to provide the necessary support to ALS teachers to ensure the effective and timely conduct of the activity.
6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are directed.
