**REMINDER ON COMPLIANCE WITH EXISTING POLICIES ON DONATIONS,  
SPONSORSHIPS, AND PARTNERSHIPS**

**TO: Asst. Schools Division Superintendent

All others concerned**

1. Relative to Memo OASPAEP-2026-078 and Regional Memo No. 00824, s. 2026, the Department of Education is committed to uphold the welfare, health, safety, and best interests of learners, thereby reiterating to strictly observe existing laws, rules, regulations, and Department policies governing the acceptance of donations, sponsorships, and partnerships from private entities and organizations.
2. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2016 (Guidelines on Accepting Donations and on Processing Applications for the Availment of Tax Incentives by Private Donor-Partners Supporting the K to 12 Program), all donations, sponsorships, and partnerships shall be carefully assessed to ensure that they are aligned with the Department's vision, mission, values and educational objectives, and do not compromise the integrity of DepEd programs and activities.
3. Likewise, DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2016 (Policy and Guidelines on Comprehensive Tobacco Control), in relation to Republic Act No. 9211 and other relevant government issuances, prohibits the acceptance of gifts, donations, sponsorships, and other forms of support, whether direct or indirect, from tobacco industry and its affiliated entities, including those coursed through corporate social responsibility (CSR) programs, foundations, partner organizations, and other intermediary groups.
4. In this regard, all school heads are directed to review their partnership engagements to ensure that the above policies were not violated and division monitors are encouraged to look into these matter.
