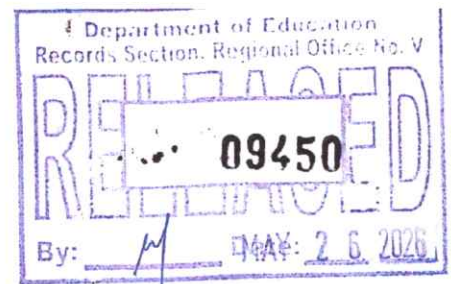

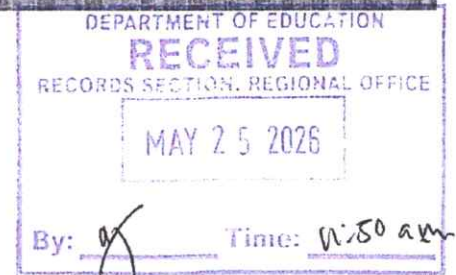

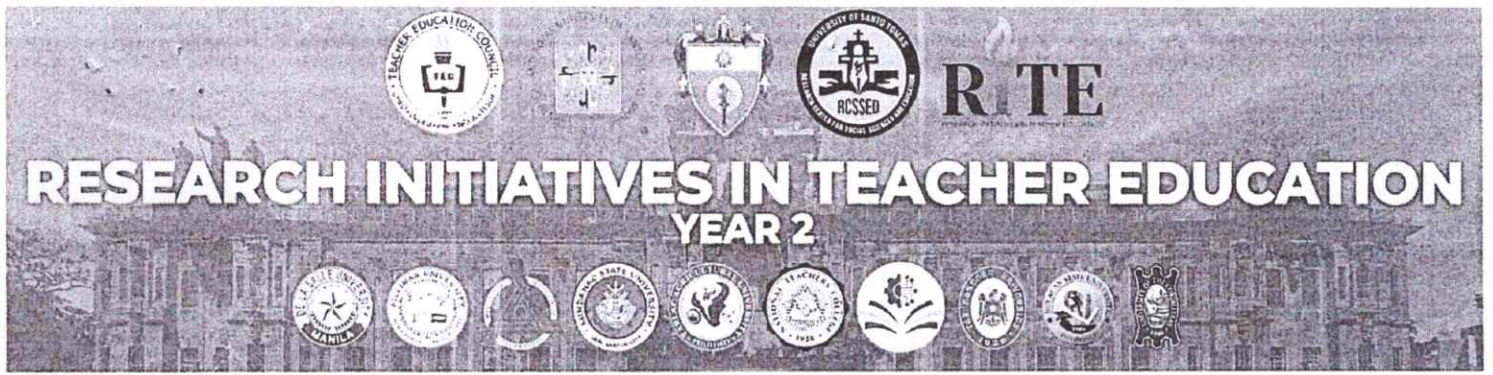
Our study is listed under Project Code T25, entitled:

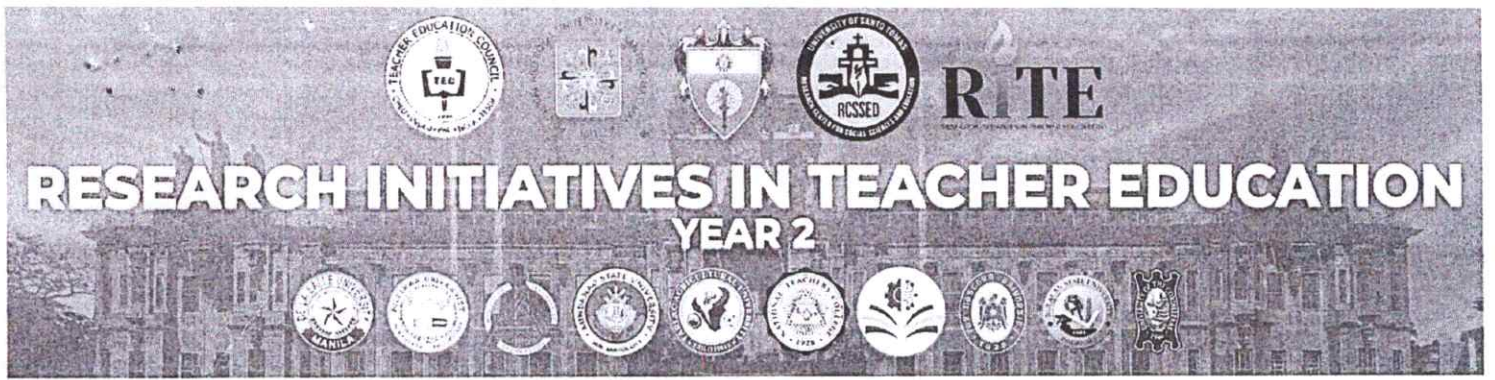
