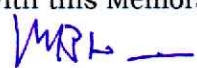

**STRICT REITERATION ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE "NO COLLECTION POLICY"
IN ALL PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS**

1. In line with the constitutional mandate to provide free public basic education and in strict compliance with DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2008, DepEd Order No. 41, s. 2012, and current national directives (including DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024), this Office strongly reiterates the absolute enforcement of the No Collection Policy.
2. Basic education must remain accessible, inclusive, and completely unburdened by financial barriers. True to our mantra, "*Sa Serbisyong Tapat at Maagap, Edukasyon ay Dekalidad*," all school heads and personnel are directed to protect the welfare of learners and their families by ensuring zero unauthorized collections.
3. To maintain the integrity of public school operations, the following rules must be strictly observed without exception. DepEd personnel (teachers, master teachers, and school heads) are strictly prohibited from collecting, handling, or safekeeping any Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) or student organization funds.
4. School Heads are explicitly directed to maximize the allocation and utilization of their School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) to cover all operational needs.
5. Teachers and school staff must not spend out-of-pocket for classroom setups, lesson reproductions, or minor repairs. The School MOOE must be managed strategically to fulfill these needs transparently.
6. All schools must post a copy of this Memorandum, along with a clear "NO COLLECTION POLICY" Advisory Billboard, at the school gate and bulletin boards, to inform parents and the community.
7. Widest dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
