INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RESILIENCY REX 2026

1. Pursuant to the request of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) of Iriga City dated July 8, 2026, this Office requests all concerned school heads to identify and endorse learners who will participate in the Resiliency Rex 2026, to be conducted on July 13-15, 2026, as part of the celebration of the 2026 National Disaster Resilience Month.
2. The Resiliency Rex 2026 aims to strengthen disaster preparedness, resilience, and emergency response awareness among learners through various Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) activities. The activity seeks to promote a culture of preparedness and resilience among the youth of Iriga City.
3. Participants in this activity shall be selected public elementary school learners, as recommended by their respective School Heads. The completion of the online registration shall serve as the school's official endorsement of the participating learners.

5. To ensure the safety and monitor the learners during the whole duration of the activity, the School Head may designate a chaperone from non-teaching personnel to attend with the learner.

6. Furthermore, participating learners are required to submit a duly signed **parent's consent form** as per **DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 re: Implementing Guidelines in the Conduct of Off-Campus Activity**. Each school shall likewise



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adhere to **Division Memorandum No. 262, s. 2025 titled Co-Curricular/Extra-Curricular Activities Safety Monitoring Mechanism** and **use the Activity Log Card** provided in this memorandum.

7. There shall be **no registration fees charged to or collected** from any learner participant. All expenses such as the meals and venue related to the conduct of this activity shall be shouldered by the hosting agency including the chaperone. Any travel expenses incurred by this activity may be charged to the school's MOOE or other available funding sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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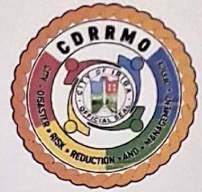

- **July 16, 2026 (Thursday)** – 100 Secondary Private School Participants

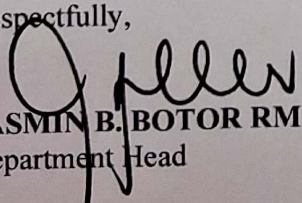
