1. Sustainable partnership with stakeholders to address challenges in schools is essential not only during Brigada Eskwela but all throughout the school year and the years thereafter. In this regard, the Schools Division Office of Iriga City calls for submission of documents for the selection of sustainable partnership in education award.
2. The division will be adopting the criteria for selection of sustainable partnerships in education award as stated in Regional Memorandum No. 623, s. 2024 re: Addendum/Corrigendum to the Regional Memorandum No. 551, s. 2024 on Stakeholders' Convergence and Awarding Ceremonies. Attached is a copy of the said criteria.
3. Interested schools shall prepare their CY 2026 Brigada Eskwela Accomplishment documents according to the order of the criteria and submit **one copy** at the SGOD Office on or before August 3, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.
4. Evaluation of documents will be done on August 11 and 12, 2026. School Brigada Eskwela Coordinator (one per school only) is requested to be present during the evaluation. In case of unavailability of the School Brigada Eskwela Coordinator, the School Head can attend the activity. Venue is at the SGOD Office.
5. Schedule of schools for evaluation will be posted in the SocMob group.
6. The selected top schools for each category will prepare and submit a video highlighting the school's best practices and volunteer activities captured during the Brigada Eskwela activities. This will be submitted on or before August 24, 2026.
