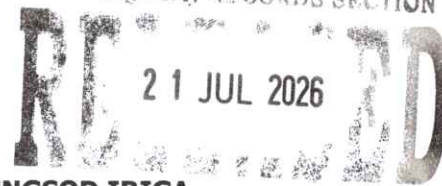

- A. **Circular Blue Border:** The blue circular border signifies unity, continuity, and excellence in delivering quality education. The circle also symbolizes inclusivity, collaboration, and the lifelong pursuit of learning.
- B. **Official Seal of the Schools Division Office of Iriga City:** Positioned at the top center, the official seal establishes the logo's identity and affirms that the Curriculum Implementation Division operates under the authority and direction of the Schools Division Office of Iriga City. It reflects institutional integrity, accountability, and commitment to public service.
- C. **Stylized "CID" Design:** The modern and interconnected design of the letters C-I-D represents innovation, collaboration, and continuous improvement in curriculum implementation.

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- Blue Letter “C” (Curriculum) – symbolizes trust, professionalism, competence, and the Division’s commitment to delivering quality and standards-based education.
- Gold Letter “I” (Implementation) – signifies knowledge, innovation, excellence, and the central role of effective curriculum implementation in achieving learner success. The three vertical gold lines also represent the collaboration among schools, communities, and stakeholders in advancing educational goals.
- Red Letter “D” (Division) – symbolizes passion, dedication, resilience, and transformational leadership in ensuring effective supervision, technical assistance, and support to schools.

D. **Continuous Line Design:** The unbroken lines forming the letters emphasize continuity in learning, lifelong education, seamless collaboration, and the interconnectedness of all educational programs and services. They also represent the Division’s commitment to sustainable improvement and educational innovation.

E. **White Background:** The white background signifies transparency, integrity, accountability, and the noble purpose of public service. It reflects the Division’s commitment to honest, learner-centered, and quality education.

F. **“IRIGA CITY” Inscription:** The inscription highlights the Division’s local identity and pride while emphasizing its dedication to serving the learners, teachers, schools, and communities of Iriga City.
