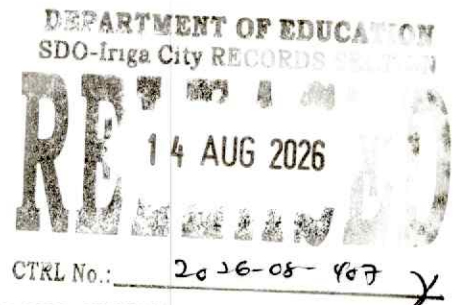

**REITERATION OF THE GUIDELINES ON THE SUPERVISION AND IMPLEMENTATION
OF CAREER GUIDANCE PROGRAM (CGP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisor, SGOD
Division Learner Formation Focal Persons
Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to Joint Memorandum OUOPS No. 2023-03-8149, entitled Guidelines on the Supervision and Implementation of the DepEd Career Guidance Program (CGP) for School Year 2023-2024, this Office reiterates the continued effectivity and application of the specified guidelines for School Year 2026-2027.
2. Pending the official issuance of a new DepEd Order, the provisions of the aforementioned Joint Memorandum shall remain in full force and effect as the governing policy to ensure the uninterrupted delivery of career guidance services, helping learners make informed decisions regarding their post-secondary exits (Higher Education, Employment, Middle-Level Skills Development, or Entrepreneurship).
3. School Division Office and secondary schools are directed to strictly observe the following core components:
 - a. All public junior and senior high schools (Grades 7 to 12) shall integrate the prescribed Career Guidance Modules into their class schedules;
 - b. Homeroom Guidance teachers and designated Career Advocates shall facilitate these modules using the approved instructional materials;
 - c. In schools without Registered Guidance Counselors (RGCs), School Heads shall designate Career Advocates in accordance with existing DepEd guidelines to oversee module implementation and learner tracking; and
 - d. School implementation must emphasize the establishment and continuous updating of each learner's Career Portfolio to track their progress, interests, and exit preferences.
4. The Division Learner Formation Focal Person, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), shall monitor the compliance of schools.
5. For wide dissemination and strict compliance.
