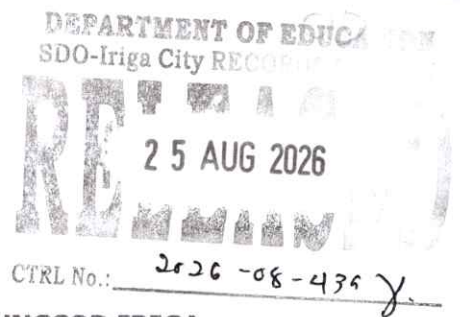

ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE SCHOOL LEARNING CONTINUITY SURVEY

1. The Department of Education, through the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, issued DM-OULS-2026-357 dated August 25, 2026, entitled "School Learning Continuity Survey," directing all public elementary and secondary schools to accomplish the School Learning Continuity Survey. In view thereof, all public elementary and secondary schools in the Schools Division of Iriga City are hereby directed to accomplish the said survey completely, accurately, and within the prescribed period.

2. The survey is intended to gather information on how schools have maintained learning continuity while prioritizing the well-being of learners and teachers during recent class suspensions arising from various circumstances. It likewise seeks to determine the perceived effectiveness of the strategies adopted by schools, including their implementation within the context of the three-term school calendar.

3. All School Heads of public elementary and secondary schools shall ensure the completion of the School Learning Continuity Survey on or before **August 26, 2026, at 12:00 noon**, as prescribed in the Regional/DepEd Memorandum. 4. RESPONSIBILITIES

A. School Heads shall:

- ensure the complete and accurate accomplishment of the survey;
- coordinate with concerned personnel in gathering and validating the required information;
- ensure submission within the prescribed deadline; and
- maintain appropriate documentation or records related to the school's learning continuity strategies, as may be necessary for validation or future reference.
